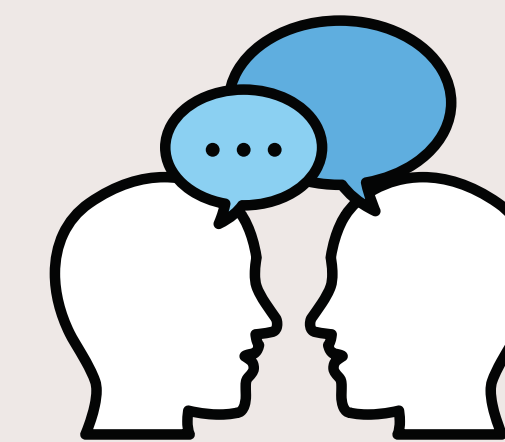
# HOW TO WALK SOMEONE THROUGH DISCIPLESHIP

5 STEPS TO A GREAT DISCIPLESHIP EXPERIENCE



## 1) CONNECTION

Take time to see how the person is doing. How can you pray for them? Spend some time building rapport and connecting with them.



## 2) HOW DID YOU GO?

Ask them how they are going with what they have been learning about God and their faith. How did they go with what was discussed the previous week/the initial salvation prayer/the last thing they learned about Jesus?



## 3) PRAY FOR THEM

Take some time to pray for them and their needs. Pray hunger into them. Pray a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Jesus Christ (Ephesians 1:17).



## 4) READ SCRIPTURE AND DISCUSS.

For each lesson, read through the scriptures and discussion questions from the material based on the pillars of INTIMACY - IDENTITY - INCREASE.



## 5) PRAY AND PROPHECY.

Pray into what they are learning. Prophecy over them and leave them feeling encouraged!

# INTIMACY 1

Quote: We intimately know God as His redeemed sons and daughters, and we are recognized in the world by our love for one another."

Reconciliation – You have been restored in connection with a God who loves you - Discuss this.

- **What does Jesus say we must do to be saved?** Mark 16:16, John 3:16, Mark 1:14-15
  - Repent: To turn from sin, to God
  - Believe: Putting our faith in Jesus to save us from sin
  - Baptism: The natural next step in our commitment to Christ
- 
- **What will happen to us once we accept Jesus?**
  - All our sins have been totally forgiven: 1 John 1:9, Romans 8:1
  - We have been re-united to God, and can approach Him Boldly: Hebrews 4:16, 1 John 5:14, Romans 8:38-39
  - We are Transformed, born again of God's Spirit: 2 Corinthians 5:17, 1 John 3:1, John 1:12-13
  - We have been set free from a life of sin: Romans 6:6-7, 1 Peter 1:18-19

Baptism - Read Matthew 28:19-20; Romans 6:3-4. Baptism is the natural next step in committing our lives to Jesus Christ, in that our old sin-ruled self has died with Christ and we have been raised to a new life in Christ Jesus.

The goodness of God - Knowing the goodness and the love of God revealed in Christ (Colossians 1:15, 1 John 1:5)

Next Steps: Repentance - Is there anything in my life I must now turn from in following Jesus?

# INTIMACY 2

Relationship with God...What it looks like (& practical tips):

- The Word of God - Hebrews 4:12
- Prayer
- Fellowship with the Holy Spirit -Developing healthy daily habits of fellowshiping with the Holy Spirit through the scriptures and in prayer.(2 Corinthians 13:14, John 14:26)
- Encounter - The priority and pursuit of His presence through personal and corporate worship, prayer and encounter.(John 4:24, Ephesians 5:18)
- Worship

Baptism in the Holy Spirit & Speaking in tongues - We believe that the Holy Spirit is God and was sent to comfort, teach and guide us in our journey, while at the same time convicting the world of sin, righteousness and judgment. We believe that all Christians can be baptised and filled with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit empowers believers with spiritual gifts such as prophecy and speaking in tongues for the service of the church and world, and fills us with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness and self-control (Acts 2:4/Acts 19:6)

Activation: Spend time praying for one another. Invite the Holy Spirit to enter into your conversation, and spend time encountering Him. Use worship music and the Bible if needed.

# IDENTITY 1

## As He is....Read and Discuss each scripture:

- 1 John 4:17
- 2 Peter 1:3
- 2 Corinthians 5:17-21
- Galatians 2:20
- Romans 6:5
- 2 Peter 1:4
  
- New Creation (not broken; not sinful; new nature) - Galatians 2:20; 2 Peter 1:4
- You now have a new nature, and you are a NEW creation.
  
- Freedom from sin - Romans 6
- You are no longer a sinner on the inside. You no longer have a sinful nature.
  
- Sonship - Ephesians 1:5 / John 1:12-13/Ephesians 5:8
- You are now a son/daughter. You are no longer an orphan, without a family or without affirmation from a loving Father. You have an inheritance! You are born of God, and full of light!
  
- Authority as a child of God - We prioritise growing in demonstrating the Kingdom and God's love through the gifts of the Spirit, divine healing and a miraculous, revival culture.(John 14:12, Mark 16:17-18)

Discuss the following quote, based upon the scripture above: "Jesus is the truth about God and the truth about us."

# IDENTITY 2

## Authority as a Son/Daughter...Read and Discuss each scripture

- Ephesians 2:6
- 2 Peter 1:4
- Matthew 28:18-19
- Luke 10:19
- Mark 11:23
  
- Healing - 1 John 5:14-15 / Luke 9:1 / Luke 10:19 / Mark 16:17-18
  
- Deliverance - Mark 16:17-18
  
- Prayer and faith - Hebrews 11:6 / Hebrews 10:22 / Mark 11:22-24
  
- There is power in the Name of Jesus! Read Colossians 2:12-15 in several different translations.
  
- When you made Jesus Christ the Lord of your life, Colossians 1:13 says you were delivered from the power of darkness. The word **power** is literally translated **authority**. You have been delivered from the power, or authority, of darkness and placed into God's kingdom. Jesus said, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore...(Matt. 28:18,19). That power was given to you as part of your inheritance in Christ Jesus. You have entered into this position of authority because you are in Him.

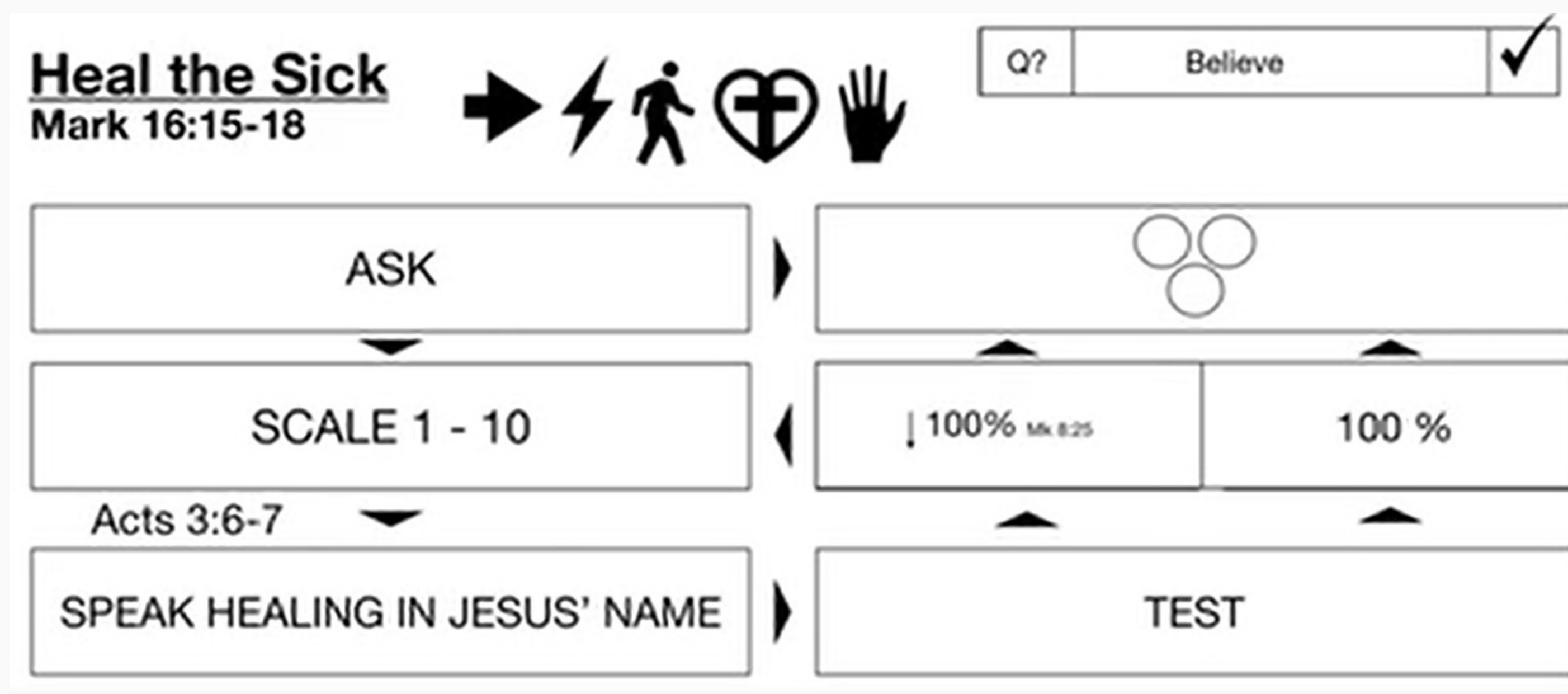
ACTIVATION TOGETHER: What are some things that you can pray for, for each other? Be specific, and practice taking authority over these things. Watch the turn around!



Manifestations of the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth - Read and discuss each scripture

- Mark 16:17-18
- Matthew 6:10
- Matthew 10:1
- 2 Peter 1:4
- Power & Gifts of the Holy Spirit - 1 Corinthians 12
- Prophetic - We seek to grow in hearing His voice, releasing His words and cultivating an apostolic culture which empowers, releases and outworks His purposes. (1 Corinthians 14:1, 1 Corinthians 12:28-31) - Discuss the prophetic and how it has impacted your life.
- Healing - Miracles beyond our wildest dreams to break out daily; Blind eyes and deaf ears to be opened, and the dead to be raised. - How can this happen as increase in your life?

TEACH THE HEALING MODULE - See below:



Read and discuss the following quote and scripture:

- Evangelism - "A natural expression of knowing that you are found in Christ" - Ps. Mandy Woodhouse
- "Then He said to them, 'Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.' They immediately left their nets and followed Him." - Matthew 4:19-20
- Can you articulate WHY you dropped everything to follow Jesus? What about Jesus is enough for people to drop everything to follow Him?
- Healthy families raise healthy children! We seek to reach the lost and disciple them in a healthy family culture. (Matthew 28:18-20, Matthew 9:37-38, Acts 6:7)
- 2 Corinthians 5:11-21
- John 3:16
- 1 John 4:17
- Proverbs 28:1
- Great Commission - Mathew 28. The Great Commission is for all Christians. If we can articulate why we dropped everything to follow Jesus, we can tell others about Him.
